



Client-facing Business Analyst - Permanent (with PM experience)

Overview:

Initially, this role is to work with the data team of one of Cyoda's clients to help them use our low-code data platform to substantially accelerate the delivery of new data sources onto their own Regtech platform (which is used by a range of T1 global banks)

Our data integration module is designed to allow analysts to configure complex mapping logic within a UX, avoiding the need to hard-code ETLs. The no-code data integration module works alongside a UX-based workflow tool (a graphically configured, event-driven finite state-machine). This is a low-code tool, designed to enable close collaboration between BAs, developers and Product teams for rapid development of data processing logic.

As well as the client-side data and business analysts, you'll be working alongside Cyoda developers who will help with mapping and deliver usability enhancements in an agile fashion. We're looking for someone who also has the project management experience to be able to be the Cyoda lead for this small project, spending approximately 25% of the time as the client-facing PM. Therefore good communication skills, political awareness and excellent English are essential.

In addition, because our data integration module is relatively new, we need to improve end-user experience so we'd also like you to provide a 'client voice' to feed ideas back to us to drive forward internal Product development.

Career Progression:

Once you have a good understanding of our technology, we're looking for this role to be a mix of client-facing implementation consulting and Product management, helping to shape the future direction of our client offering..
